By Road:

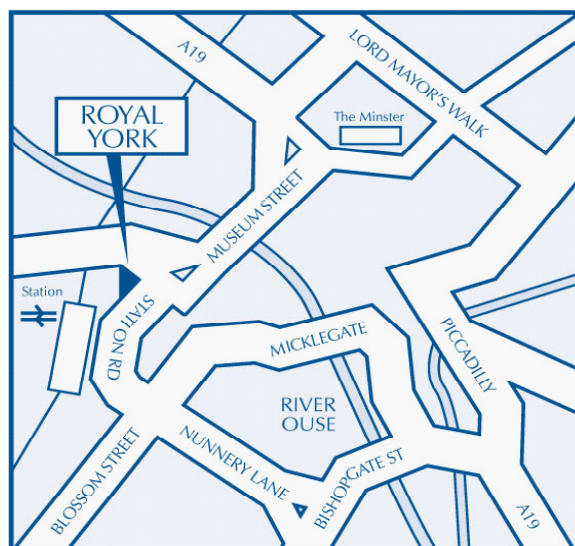
